


Front Panel

- 1. Indicator of Power input
- 2. Input Select Button: Manually select button to switch signal source.
- 3. IR Receiver
- 4. Indicator of HDMI output. When an HDMI equipment is connected, the corresponding LED light will be on.
- Indicator of HDMI Input. When an HDMI equipment is connected, the corresponding LED light will be on.
- 6. HDMI input ports
- 7. Power input
- 8. HDMI output port

CONNECTING AND OPERATING

- 1) Connect the HDMI signal sources (Such as PS3, STB etc) into HDMI input.
- Connect the HDMI display device (Such as HD-LCD, HD-DLP) into HDMI output.Attention: Insert/Extract cables gently.

MAINTENANCE

Clean this unit with a soft, dry cloth. Never use alcohol, paint thinner of benzine to clean this unit.

PRODUCT SERVICE

1) Damage requiring service:
